


'BJP will breach 282 mark by large margin', Amit Shah

Indian American Yadvinder Singh Sandhu sentenced to 5 Years in Jail

(By our staff reporter) Washington DC: : A 61year-old Indian has been jailed for five years in the US over charges of illegally helping foreigners, including a majority of Indians, enter into the country, the US Department of Justice has said. Yadvinder Singh Sandhu pleaded guilty early this year, saying he personally assisted around 400 people to unlawfully enter the US between 2013 and 2015. The smuggling carried out by him resulted in at least one death and endangered the lives of many, the Department of Justice said. Mr Sandhu, charged in an indictment returned by a federal grand jury in the District of Puerto Rico on March 15, 2017, used multiple aliases including Yadvinder Singh Bhamba,

Will the prime minister's message work? It is aimed at domestic benefits, security and swing voters

this is a high-stakes election, meant to determine the future of the country(ANI)

In an interview to this newspaper, Prime Minister Narendra Modi emphasised that this is a high-stakes election, meant to determine the future of the country. It was not an election for a "class monitor". The PM is right. While each election has had its own importance in India's history, this election is perhaps more important than most because of the competing visions of different players in the battle. And at the centre of it is Mr Modi himself. The outcome will reveal whether the electorate is satisfied with his record in office, or whether there is a degree of disenchantment and anger deep enough to oust him.

Mr Modi's message can be divided into three distinct categories, meant for three different categories of voters. First, in terms of domestic performance, he reiterated the government's achievements on welfare. from providing rural housing to gas cylinders, from toilet construction to Ayushman Bharat. These are indeed important contributions; the Bharatiya Janata Party has made them a talking point and it is intended to broaden the party's class appeal. Mr Modi defended his record on job creation — but this is an

In an interview to this newspaper, Prime raised about the government's policies. Two, Minister Narendra Modi emphasised that the PM has continued to focus on national security. By suggesting that India has decided to inflict costs to sponsoring terror and "in the future" too, terror attacks from Pakistan could well be "detrimental" for its existence, he has redefined Delhi's redlines and strategic paradigm. Besides its foreign policy implications, politically, this message has enthused the party base and supporters and taken up a notch the emotive content of the party's messaging. And finally, the PM recast this election as a battle between a strong government and a chaos-ridden coalition which has multiple interests pulling it in different directions. This message is aimed at the swing voters, who may be apprehensive of such an alternative.

The PM has largely been disciplined about his messaging on these themes in this campaign. But there is no doubt that there have also been occasions when he - and other leaders — have engaged in bitter personal allegations, leading to a dip in the nature of discourse. Mr Modi did concede that courtesy should be maintained, but added that he has been a victim of such attacks. The most damaging failure of the UPA is the coinage of the term Hindu terror

The Pragya Thakur vs Digvijaya Singh battle will be seen as one between a victim of a politically motivated investigation and a person who coined the term Hindu terror

The National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government has been successful in curbing terrorism, though there have been some attacks in Jammu and Kashmir which can be attributed to the desperation of the terrorist outfits, thanks to the strong measures taken against them. This includes, giving a free hand to the Armed Forces and the police in counter-insurgency operations, arrests of separatists, banning terrorist outfits and the withdrawal of security for separatists.

Though the United Progressive Alliance (UPA) is remembered for its many failures, the most damaging of them is the coinage of the term "Hindu terror". This was done by a party that has always propagated appeasement politics. The sinister design of the Congress in coining this term is to create an artificial equivalence of Islamic State terror, which is a major threat in many parts of the world.

The purpose of inventing this term is to appease Muslims and to hurt the pride of the Hindu community. The BJP has maintained the stand that terrorism has no religion. The Congress, as the principal opposition party, has taken the dangerous route of communal politics.

The first Malegaon blast took place on September 8, 2006, the Mecca Masjid blast was on May 18, 2007, the Samjhauta Express bombings were on February 18, 2007. The second Malegaon blast happened on September 29, 2008. The UPA government had six to eight years to investigate these cases but it was not able to prosecute these successfully. It is evident in each of the cases how shoddy and politically motivated investigation, the politics of appeasement and the desire for power eclipsed the needs of national security as far as

the UPA was concerned.

In the 2006 Malegaon blast case, nine Muslim suspects were charge-sheeted by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and the Maharashtra Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS). However, in 2011, after the Mumbai attack, the National Investigation Agency took over the case and filed a supplementary charge-sheet against the alleged Hindu activists, paving way for the release of all the Muslim accused.

In the Mecca Masjid blast, initially around 24 Muslims were picked up who allegedly receivied training in Pakistan, but all of them were later let off for lack of evidence. The probe was handed over to the CBI in 2010 and later on to the NIA in 2011. Finally, charge-sheet was filed by the NIA against 10 alleged Hindu activists.

In the Samjhauta blast of 2007, in spite of intelligence inputs being shared by the US of the proven links of one Arif Qasmani, a Pakistani national who had links with Pakistani terrorist organisations, the Congress government changed the course of investigation to implicate alleged Hindu terrorists, one of which was Srikant Purohit, a serving army officer who lost eight years and eight months of his life.

This also gave Pakistan an opportunity to point fingers at India and to dilute the Indian stand that Pakistan promotes terrorism in India.

The Bombay High Court, while granting bail to Pragya Thakur, has stated in its order dated of April 25, 2017: "Thus, in respect of above witnesses, apart from retraction and allegation of torture, their statements give two contradictory versions...In above facts and circumstances, in our considered opinion, if both the reports of ATS and NIA are considered conjointly, so far as the appellant is concerned, it cannot be said that there are reasonable grounds for believing that accusation made against her are prima facie true.'

Elephant banned due to health, Kerala jumbo owners ban fest

centrepiece of Kerala's popular temple festival, Thrissur Pooram, since the late 18th century when the erstwhile Kochi royal family started it. The week-long festival at Thrissur's Vadakkumnathan Temple would not be the same when it starts this year on Monday without the parade.

The elephant owners have announced a boycott of the festival in protest against the ban on a 54year-old tusker, Thechikottukavu Ramachandran, from participating in Thrissur Pooram.


The elephant, which suffers from a partial loss of vision, has been the centre of attraction at the festival since the 1970s. It was barred from participating in the festival after trampling two people to death in February. The elephant has been symbolically pushing open the Vadakkumnathan Temple's southern entrance to mark the beginning of Thrissur Pooram for four decades.

Kerala's Elephant Owners' Federation general

A parade of around 50 elephants has been the secretary, P Sasikumar, told IANS that a decision to allow the elephant take part in the festival was taken at a meet forest minister K Raju presided over on April 10. "We do not know what happened after that."

Sasikumar called the ban on the elephant a rude jolt. "Hence, we decided that from May 11, not a single elephant of ours will be given for taking part in any festival. This one-sided decision is not acceptable to us," said Sasikumar, whose organisation is the only body of owners of captive elephants in the state.

R Chandran, president of Thechikottukavu Devasom that owns Ramachandran, echoed Sasikumar and called the ban a shock. "There is some conspiracy behind this sudden change in a decision that was already taken. We hope better sense prevails," said Chandran. "It is common knowledge that Ramachandran's right eye has a vision problem while his left eye is 100% fit."





(News Agencies) New Delhi: Bharatiya Janata Party president Amit Shah admits that there is no "soft side" to him and says that national politics is "serious business", which he doesn't do "fun". The 54-year-old for Gandhinagar Lok Sabha candidate has canvassed for his party in no less than 290 constituencies to date in this election season. In the past five years, Shah has also visited almost all districts in India save a couple of remote ones in Arunachal Pradesh and has stayed a night in as many as 212 districts. A prominent media journalist on campaign trail with BJP president asked him a range of questions on the prospects of his party, the NDA and about the performance of the Narendra Modi government.

Q : In 2014 Lok Sabha elections, the BJP alone won 282 seats. Will this number increase or go down? What is your assessment after five rounds of polling?

The 282 number will be breached by a large margin by the BJP; even the tally of the NDA will go up. Our analysis of the rounds of voting complete shows that not only the number of seats but also the winning margin will increase and the spread of the BJP/NDA will increase in terms of area.

Q: Why do you think people will vote for the BJP?

Firstly, the public has faith and confidence in Prime Minister Narendra Modi. We can perceive the enthusiasm among the electorate in making Modi PM again. Secondly, the Modi government has done all-round development. This is matched by taking India up the global ladder in terms of GDP growth and making the country proud. Besides, PM Modi has assured 125 crore Indians that his government is committed to national security, which is the topmost priority of his regime -- whether it is taking tough decisions on Jammu and Kashmir or being the most successful government in handling international diplomacy and challenges. In all these issues, the public has seen sweeping positive change from the past. I feel that in PM Modi, people have found a leader who can be sensitive, yet has the capacity to take tough decisions. Q: As evident in your rallies

today, you have made national security a major election issue. Do you really believe that national security is a vote catcher?

Since the 1990s, the public has wanted national security to be a priority. They were longing for a focused strategy, where, diplomatically, India could boldly present its views to other countries and at the same time strike at the source of terror. Till re-

cently, all the wars against terror term seems not so much in country. These 50 crore did not were fought on Indian soil. We have suffered on this count. It is only under Modi that India has struck twice at the place of origin of terrorists in form of the 2016 surgical strike and 2019 airstrike at Balakot. When the surgical strike happened, defence experts from all over said that it was a fluke and not policy. After the airstrike, the same experts agree that this is the defence policy of India and Narendra Modi.

For the first time since independence, the country's diplomatic policy has been separated from its defence policy. This is why national security is an important issue. Not that other issues have been side-lined. The 22 crore beneficiaries of the BJP government know that it is Modi who has given them their due. They also know that only Modi can give their due to those who are left behind. Besides, there have been agricultural reforms with increased rate of growth, increased coverage of irrigation, faster infrastructure development with 2.5 times increase in road and 2 25 times increase in railroad construction.

Q: The Congress says that even it conducted six surgical strikes

Nobody says this except Congress president Rahul Gandhi. Q: But former prime minister Manmohan Singh has also said the same?

Congress has to follow the footsteps of Rahul Gandhi.

Q: The Opposition has questioned the timing of UN designation of Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) chief Masood Azhar as a global terrorist in the midst of general elections...

You mean to say that UN's 1267 committee should have postponed the meeting and waited for the 2019 Lok Sabha elections to get over. The terror tag on Masood Azhar is the biggest diplomatic victory of Narendra Modi and it comes after the world community recognised India's right to self defence after the February 14 Pulwama suicide attack and the Balakot retaliation. It has also recognised that Pakistan is sheltering terrorists and terror groups. Q: Will the Masood listing help vou in the 2019 elections?

It is an achievement of the Modi government, so why should we not take electoral advantage of it. Q: In the 2014 elections and all through the assembly elections since, we heard the term social engineering when it came to wining elections. The that they have a stake in the

voque now?

It is not that the term is missing but BJP does not need to do social engineering frequently as the party has become inclusive -- all sections of society finds representation in our party. In the past five years there has been a development that will strengthen democracy - elections are no longer a prisoner of caste, dynasties and appeasement. Narendra Modi, through his politics of performance has got rid of these ulcers.

Q : Do you think politics of performance or development will work in a country where people vote in the name of caste and religion ?

There are many examples to counter this -- for instance Assam, Manipur and most importantly Uttar Pradesh where BJP got 325 assembly seats without projecting any caste leader. We got good results in those states as we worked towards solving grievances of the people without keeping caste, creed or religion in mind

Q: So you think that caste equations will not matter even in UP and Bihar in the on-going election?

I have not said that. I am saying this time voting in these states is not predominantly on caste. Caste-based parties are losing influence. Today, the public understands that caste based parties will help only their caste. In UP for instance, when Samajwadi Party comes to power, one caste gets a boost, similarly BSP majority helps only its supporting caste. The remaining 80 castes remain neglected. BJP with its "Saabka Saath, Sabka Vikas" mantra has been able to transcend castes by doing development work without asking caste of the beneficiary. Q: Tell me three reasons why people should vote for BJP? First. BJP has a strong leader, while the opposition leadership is in tatters. The public wants to know the leader or PM candidate of the diverse parties opposing Modi. In contrast, we have given a strong, decisive leader, the most popular Indian mass leader since Independence. To add to this, the NDA recognises and accepts the leadership of Modi. Second, we have made the 50 crore poor in this country realise

have a house, electricity, drinking water, cooking gas, toilets for women and health benefits. Today, every poor person has these facilities in 165000 villages due to the BJP government at Centre. There are 22 crore beneficiaries whose life has been positively impacted by this change. Third, as opposed to indecisive or leaderless governments in the past. our decisive leadership has addressed the challenges related to economy, defence, infrastructure, agriculture, or poverty alleviation on every platform or level.

Q: There is one school of thought that says the BJP will end up with 180 seats in 2019 elections leaving the space for opposition to cobble up an alternative.

This theory was active in the runup to the 2014 results. First, they said the BJP will not make Modiji a PM candidate, then they said lack of full majority will block Modi as PM, then they said Modi will not be able to form a stable government. The same people said BJP will lose Guiarat and UP. This time also, the public will smash all their illusions.

Q: The BJP announced a farm pay out. The Congress has promised a NYAY scheme. Can we say that India is slowly moving towards a cash transfer/payout system like universal basic income when it comes to welfare?

To link the BJP's scheme with a vote catching plan of the opposition, to my mind is due to lack of proper information. In this country, there are 15 crore farmers who have small to large holdings. Out of these 15 crore, only three crore get loans and remaining get nothing as they do not have requisite holding to qualify for loan. These are marginal farmers, who take loans from money-lenders on very high interest rates. This is one of the reasons for farmer suicides. A committee set up by NABARD found that the input cost for small and marginal farmers was Rs 6000 per year for two crops. Just as new industry is promoted by viability gap funding, we decide to respect the farmer by giving him Rs 6000 per year so that he/she did not have to go to the money-lender. This is not a gift. This is just a tonic for the farmer to keep tilling his small piece of land. You will be committing a big mistake if you compare this with cash transfer. Modi government schemes are not doles for votes but serious attempts to lift the status of the beneficiary.

Q: Data shows that the increase in minimum support prices (MSPs) has not really helped the farmers. Not enough is being procured. What do you see as a long term sustainable solution?

Your information is half baked on this issue. Wheat and rice constitute 60% crop in India Today the procurement of these two staple crops is done at 1.5 times its input cost. We have added 24 new crops, eight months ago but the full implementation of this novel scheme requires 1.5-2 years with the help of Centrestate governments. My firm belief is that the farmers will be able to get 1.5 times input price for 24 crops, Rabi and Kharif crops. This is just a beginning. We have told the farmer that government is with you as 70% of crops such as dal from Gujarat, Bajra from Maharashtra, Ragi in Karnataka are being purchased by Centre and states. I believe that media should play a positive role in taking this Modi initiative to farmers. Q: You have talked about getting rid of Article 370, 35A in order to integrate Jammu and Kashmir? Are your NDA allies on board with this?

BJP is totally committed on getting rid of these two articles. We are firm. We will take our allies on board by explaining to them. This is our concrete promise to Indian public. The same applies to our Uniform Civil Code promise

Q: How committed are you to women reservation bill, Ram Temple and Citizenship Amendment Bill (CAB)?

For women reservation bill, we need consensus among all political parties. It will not happen till this agreement is reached. But we will make all attempts to get all political parties on board. We will definitely bring the CAB and get it cleared through Rajya Sabha too.

Q: When will it happen?

One more round of UP/Bihar of Rajya Sabha polls and things will change in favour of the BJP (in the upper house).

Q: On Ram Mandir?

The Supreme Court has ordered eight weeks of mediation, which will end in June 2019. The case will be taken up after vacation. We will wait for the results. I have firm belief that the Supreme Court will take the route taken by Allahabad High Court.

Q: Sadhvi Pragya Thakur was a terror accused, she is on bail, yet you chose her to contest Lok Sabha elections from **Bhopal? Why?**

Please study the charge sheet of Sadhvi Pragya. She has not been accused of planting a bomb but being part of a conspiracy

meeting for Malegoan, Samajhauta Express and Mecca Masjid blasts. The judgment in Mecca Masjid and Samajhauta Express blast has come. Court has dismissed the conspiracy meeting as imagination, bereft of any evidence. The conspiracy theory has been rejected by two Indian courts and they have said that there is no such thing as Hindu terror. Since two courts have rejected the conspiracy, there is no need to count Sadhvi as an accused. Sadhvi got a Lok Sabha ticket as a riposte to Congress vote bank politics by defaming the Hindu religion by adding the word terror to it. And to expose this, there was no better seat as Hindu terror is the brainchild of Congress leader Digvijaya Singh (the candidate from Bhopal). Immigrant Arrests Smash Records, and U.S. Border Struggles to Handle the Crush

(News Agencies) Donna, Texas—After tens of thousands of families streamed across America's southern border late last year, a Catholic charity in Tucson, Ariz., opened a monastery to house asylum-seeking migrants whom federal agents released. The 66.000-square-foot space is now full. The recent discovery of an unused closet caused excitement.

An additional 113,797 people in families had crossed this year by the end of March, and border agents in El Paso, Texas, housed some under a bridge. Last month, Yuma, Ariz., declared an emergency after a converted strip-mall thrift store serving as a shelter hit capacity. Last week, a giant white tent opened on the outskirts of Donna, near the Rio Grande—the government's latest desperate attempt to house the families.

In April, a single-month record of 58,000 parents and children crossing together illegally were arrested, federal data released Wednesday show.

A deepening humanitarian crisis on the border is straining towns, aid groups and federal agencies as thousands of families, when released, immediately need shelter.

The border has seen illegal-immigrant waves before. This one is different.

Instead of the single job seekers of a decade ago who aimed to sneak in undetected, these are families openly seeking asylummore like the groups of refugees familiar on borders elsewhere in the world, where wars, famine and genocide have created massive camps of displaced families with nowhere to go.

Families arrive at a U.S. border unprepared to absorb the sheer numbers of adults and children who are, by law, allowed to remain at least temporarily-confounding federal policy and the Trump administration. It is getting more chaotic, as Border Patrol officials shuttle immigrants hundreds of miles to find space.

According to the new federal data, 248,000 parents and children had illegally entered the U.S. by April since the federal fiscal year began in October, more than in any prior full year.

The families are mostly citizens of Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras citing gang violence, hunger, poverty and corruption. Trump administration officials and Republican lawmakers have argued that legal loopholes encourage asylum seekers, but those loopholes have existed for years. "President Trump has repeatedly exposed the loopholes littered

The administration has tried multiple responses: separating adults from their children, pushing Congress to change immigration law, threatening to close the border before backing down, sending troops to the border. On April 29, President Trump ordered the Department of Homeland Security and Justice Department to start drafting regulations to speed up adjudications for asylum cases, charge migrants an application fee for asylum and deny them work permits while awaiting a decision.

The migration flow and the resulting humanitarian crisis is rapidly overwhelming the ability of the federal government to respond," White House acting Office of Management and Budget director Russell Vought told Congress last Wednesday in a request for \$4.5 billion in emergency funding. The administration's moves so far have neither stopped families from arriving nor found a solution to the overcrowding and turmoil at the border.

The Ninth U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals ruled Tuesday that the Trump administration for now can resume its practice of sending some Central American asylumseekers to Mexico to wait for U.S. judge to rule in their asylum case—an unexpected victory for the administration. But that policy, which had been in effect for months before legal challenges interrupted it, has had little effect on the current crisis because of restrictions on who the government can remove.

They crossed with other Central Americans into the U.S. illegally near Calexico, Calif., a desert border town surrounded by farm and ranch lands about an hour west of the Arizona state line. They overwhelmed authorities and facilities in South Florida and forced the government to move newly arriving Cubans to temporary holding facilities at military bases around the U.S. and Puerto Rico. It became a political problem for President Carter, whose administration had been granting refugee status to any Cuban who arrived in the U.S.

The Obama administration was inundated with tens of thousand of unaccompanied migrant children and families in 2014. Children coming alone reached a high of more than 68,000 that year. While some families were sent home, most took their place in line in the massive immigration-court backlog.

A foreign national died in a boat on his way to the US, the Department of Justice alleged. At times, the smugglers would take passports from the foreigners during their journeys, physically assault them and threaten their families to collect money.

This market has been unified and various inefficiencies have been removed. While implementing any major reform some problems are natural and an alert system solves those problems quickly. Each of these schemes you have mentioned, have been unique in their speed and scale. With Swachh Bharat, a women's dignity was made the focal point of social governance. Over 9 crore toilets built in 5 years ensured that women are not forced to defecate in open and the sanitation coverage of India went up from just 38% in 2014 to 99% in 2019. With Ujjwala, again, more than 7 crore women and especially their children were freed from the choking life that they were subjected to for so long due to cooking with firewood.

Take Ayushman Bharat, the world's largest healthcare insurance programme is transforming the entire healthcare system in the country. It has made quality healthcare accessible and affordable for the poorest. Same with Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, which is fulfilling the dream of owning a house for all Indians, irrespective of which class, caste, region they belong to. PM Fasal Bima Yojana has brought immense relief to a farmer's family who no longer fear impoverishment due to crop damage.

Each of these initiatives has fundamentally changed people's lives, in a way that they have been freed from the fear and uncertainty that poverty, sickness, and homelessness bring in people's lives. These fears had tied down generations of Indians and trapped them in a cycle of poverty. But that feeling of fear, anxiety and helplessness is being driven away now. This helplessness is giving way to hope and the anxiety is giving way to aspirations.






