Pak Spy Agency Considers Me Its "Enemy", Says Indian-American Congressman

(News Agency) Indian-American Congressman Raja Krishnamoorthi has said that Pakistan's spy agency ISI considers him an "enemy" because of his stand against the radicals in the South Asian country. The Democratic Party lawmaker from Illinois said this while addressing community members during a fundraiser hosted by him in Boston at the residence of eminent Indian American R V Kapur, president of the US India Security Council (USISC). "He (Krishnamoorthi) said that the ISI in Pakistan views him as an enemy for his stand against radicals in Pakistan. He reiterated that he respected all religions and never discriminated against any colour, race or religion," according to a press statement issued by the US India Security Council. Mr Krishnamoorthi assured the Indian-American community to continue to support strategic relations

between the US and India if he won so that this friendship could deter China from its ambitions in the pacific. The lunch among others was attended by several eminent Indian Americans, including Vikram Rajyadaksha, Dinesh Patel, Abhishek Singh, Amar Sawhney, Deepika Sawhney and Dr. Raj Raina. USISC said the fundraiser was held to support Mr Krishnamoorthi for his forthcoming election in November and also to express the support of the Indian American Community for the 49-year-old Congressman's consistent and constant stand supporting causes that help the Indian-American community and also build stronger US-India relations. India Wheat Export Ban Hits Chewy Chapati Eating Punjabis In Singapore

Wheat flour from India, albeit making up only a small proportion of total imports, is sought after by Indian eateries in India as it produces soft and chewy chapati, an Indian staple

(News Agency) India's ban on wheat exports since May has hit Singapore eateries serving soft chewy chapati, mostly for Punjabis, as the cost has gone up by three times on imports of the similar in quality staple north Indian basic food material from other countries amidst the war in Ukraine, according to a media report on Tuesday. Supermarket chain FairPrice said the supply of wheat flour had been low due to increased demand in the past few weeks, possibly due to the wheat and flour ban from India. FairPrice's suppliers are sourcing wheat

flour from various countries like Sri Lanka, Australia, Canada, and the United States, according to a report by The Straits Times. "The (wheat) flour shortage will affect our business very badly. We cannot pass all the cost to our customers, we have to try and keep prices low," said Mathavan Adi Balakrishnan, managing director of Sakunthala's, one of the leading eateries in the Little India precinct here. The restaurant used to pay SGD 5 (USD 3.48) a kg for wheat flour from India, but the flour from Dubai now costs SGD 15 (USD 10.45) a kg. Singapore imports

between 200,000 and 250,000 tonnes of wheat and 100,000 to 120,000 tonnes of wheat flour annually, according to data from the United Nations. In 2020, 5.8 per cent of Singapore's total wheat flour imports were from India, The Business Times reported. The bulk of the city-state wheat flour imports come from Australia, the US, and Canada. Wheat flour from India, albeit making up only a small proportion of total imports, is sought after by Indian eateries here as it produces soft and chewy chapati, an Indian staple. India, the world's second-biggest

producer of wheat, stopped exporting the grain and its flour in May in an attempt to put a cap on skyrocketing domestic prices after a heatwave parched crops and affected wheat supply. The ban came amid Ukraine's wheat exports being curtailed by the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war. Ukraine used to be the fourthbiggest supplier of wheat to the world, accounting for about 9 per cent of the global wheat trade. Some eateries have suspended menu items like chapati, poori bhaji, and tandoori as all of them require wheat flour to make.



NavIC: All you need to know about India's home- Fix first board at your home': Cong's grown alternative to the GPS navigation system

home-grown navigation system within months. Navigation with Indian Constellation (NavIC), also called the Indian Regional **Navigation Satellite** System (IRNSS), is considered on par with US-based



GPS, Russia's Glonass and Galileo developed by Europe.Making innovative applications to the entire community in the ocean-based services, especially for the underserved and unserved, the NavIC constellation is really going to create history, according to ISRO Chairman K Sivan.

By using receivers on the ground, IRNSS-11 will help in determining position and time accurately through signals in a space covering India.Designed to provide accurate position information service to users in India as well as the region extending up to 1500 km from its boundary, NavIC, can be a part of Garmin's handheld devices GPSMAP 66sr and GPSMAP 65s.Standard Positioning Service (SPS) and Restricted Service (RS), which are provided to all and authorised users respectively,

In order to ensure the availability of NavIC signal in any part of the world, India's satellite navigation draft policy in 2021 stated the government will work towards "expanding the coverage from regional to global." With the aim of removing dependence on foreign satellite systems for navigation service requirements, NavIC is conceived particularly for "strategic sectors."

Drones to keep an eye on power transmission towers in MP from Oct 1

The state-run Madhya Pradesh Power Transmission Company Limited is going to deploy drones to monitor 10,000 high voltage towers in the state beginning October 1

(News Agency) The state-run Madhya Pradesh Power Transmission Company Limited (MPPTCL) is going to deploy drones to monitor 10,000 high voltage towers in the state beginning October 1, a senior company official said on Monday.

This is for the first time in the country that drones are going to be used to check tall towers for smooth power supply," MPPTCL Managing Director Sunil Tiwari claimed while talking to PTI. He said drones will take videos and close range pictures of the towers.

Currently, the inspection of towers is being done manually. Employees climb the towers to check the equipment and this process is very time consuming and laborious. Now, drones would do this



work, he said. "The benefit of using the drone technology is that we can take photographs and video of the equipment installed on the towers closely from all

sides," the official said. Tiwari said they decided to deploy drones after their use for inspection on an experimental basis for some months showed encouraging

results. The drones are going to be used for the inspection of 10,000 out of the 80,000 extra high voltage power transmission line towers installed across Madhya Pradesh from next month, he said. "We are taking 10,000 towers in the first phase. The drone monitoring of the rest 70,000 towers will be taken up later," he said, adding that the inspection of towers was done periodically under maintenance work."Our engineers are going to supervise the drone monitoring of towers for which a private firm has been hired," he said. The MPPTCL wheels power from the electricity generation units to distribution companies, which in turn supply electricity to households and for business purposes.







Nord Stream gas pipelines leak and a possible 'sabotage

A series of unusual leaks on two natural gas pipelines running from Russia to Germany have triggered concerns about possible sabotage

Swedish authorities have published new footage of a large-scale leak from the Nord Stream gas pipeline, which occurred as a result of sabotage

The leak comes even as the Nord Stream 1 pipeline has not been operational since August when Russia closed it down for 'maintenance'. The Nord Stream 2 pipeline, though completed, never became operational since the war broke out in Ukraine.

WHAT ARE NORD STREAM **PIPELINES?**

The Nord Stream pipelines, owned and operated by Nord Stream AG, directly links Russian gas to Europe via Germany. Russia's stateowned company Gazprom is the largest shareholder in the pipeline. The Nord Stream 1 stream, started in 2011, runs from Vyborg, Russia to the exit point in Lubmin, Germany. The 1,224 km-long Nord Stream 1 consists of two parallel pipelines which provide a maximum of 170 m cubic metres of gas per day from Russia to Germany which then link it to the European grid.

Nord Stream 2, which runs almost in parallel to Nord Stream 1, was built in September 2021. However, it was never launched even as the pipeline was filled with 300m cubic metres of gas. Later, the project came to a complete standstill after ties between Germany and Russia soured over the latter's invasion of Ukraine.

Authority issued a statement that a leak had likely occurred in one of the two Nord Stream 2 pipelines lying in Danish waters.

A few hours later, Nord Stream AG said it was looking into a drop in pressure in Nord Stream 1.

Nord Stream 1, one in the Swedish economic zone and another in the Danish zone, were northeast of Denmark's Bornholm.

The leaks happened just before the ceremonial launch of the Baltic Pipe carrying gas from Norway to Poland on Tuesday. The pipeline is an effort by Poland to decrease its dependence on Russia for energy.

WHAT ABOUT THE SABOTAGE CHARGE?

So far, there is no reason why the leak happened. However, European nations see it as the next step of Russia's aggression in Ukraine.

Russia had already decreased the supply of gas to Europe after the European Union imposed sanctions on Moscow for invading Ukraine. Flows via Nord Stream 2 were reduced to 20 per cent of its capacity in July.In August end, Russia further plugged the supply and stopped Nord Stream 1 completely, citing maintethat an oil leak in a turbine on the Nord Stream 1 pipeline was behind the closure.

With Rajasthan Mishandling, Sonia Gandhi Delivers A Massive Mistake

Is the Rajasthan crisis the end of the road for the Nehru-Gandhi family? Perhaps it is too early to call time out for them, but their status as the high command stands lowered if their writ does not run, and party leaders openly defy them. It is ironic that the man who was supposed to be the most-trusted person of the Nehru-Gandhi family is being seen as inflicting a deep wound on both them and the Congress. This crisis, in my opinion, is the biggest the family has seen since the violent death of Rajiv Gandhi; for Sonia Gandhi personally, this is her most difficult moment since she assumed the post of party President two decades ago.

After the freedom struggle, Jawaharlal Nehru was the supreme leader of the Congress with no direct challenge to his leadership. There were serious differences of opinion with Sardar Patel, but he never challenged Nehru's authority. Even in 1950, when Purushottam Das Tandon was elected the party President with Patel's blessings, it was never construed that this was done to undermine his Nehru's authority. And when Nehru realised that Tandon was trying to change the course of Congress ideology, he put his foot down and Tandon was left with no option but to resign. Nehru was so charismatic that despite a humiliating defeat to China, no Congress person could ask for his resignation. After his demise, Lal Bahadur Shastri became Prime Minister. And after his untimely death, Indira Gandhi emerged

Morarji Desai to become Prime Minister.

The members of the 'Syndicate' who thought that Indira Gandhi would be a 'goongi gudiya' (mute doll) were in for a rude shock; during the election for President in 1969, when she refused to endorse the party's official candidate, Neelam Sanjiva Reddy, the split in the party was inevitable. She asked her supporters to vote for V. V. Giri. To take the fight with the 'Syndicate' to its logical conclusion, Indira Gandhi took a left turn. The nationalisation of banks, abolition of the privy purse and Garibi Hatao (end poverty) programs were designed to boost her image as a popular leader and decimate the conservative wing of the Congress. After her defeat in 1977, her authority was again challenged by leaders like Brahmananda Reddy. The party split once again in 1978 but the Congress led by Indira Gandhi survived and successfully formed the government in 1980 and 1984.

Her son Rajiv Gandhi was not meant for politics; he was misled by his close friends and that led to the defeat of Congress due to the Bofors scandal in 1989. After his assassination in 1991, senior leaders of the Congress tried to persuade Sonia Gandhi to head the party, but she refused. This was a golden opportunity to create a new Congress without the Nehru Gandhifamily, but it failed, and finally the

as the leader of the party and defeated Congress begged Sonia Gandhi to save the party. She was greatly handicapped because of her foreign origin and confronted the opposition of the troika of Sharad Pawar, P A Sangma and Tarig Anwar. But the majority of Congressmen showed confidence in her leadership. Pawar and company left the party. If Sonia Gandhi had chosen to be the Prime Minister, instead of Manmohan Singh, there was no one to raise a banner of revolt against her. Since then, her authority has never been challenged despite two embarrassing defeats in 2014 and 2019.

> Despite her foreign origin, Congress leaders had no choice but to accept Sonia Gandhi's leadership for three reasons.

One, from 1991 to 1998, when the Congress was in the hands of non-Nehru-Gandhi leaders, a very lacklustre leadership was delivered. Narasimha Rao and Sitaram Kesri were uninspiring leaders. They had no charisma and no appeal outside the Congress.

Second, Rao and Kesri could not rise above their personal interests. They had the opportunity to give a new direction to the Congress, but they ended up as factional leaders. If Rao was constantly at war with Arjun Singh and Sharad Pawar despite being Prime Minister, Kesri was constantly threatened by the presence of Pawar. Both Rao and Kesri created their own cliques.

Why India's efforts to ban Islamist PFI need to be applauded

Islamist groups often become a pain under the nose, not only for the countries, but also for the Muslim community

Indian government under Prime Minister Narendra Modi banned the infamous Islamist outfit Popular Front of India (PFI) on Wednesday, a week after India's premier agency, the National Investigation Agency (NIA) carried out a massive crackdown on last Thursday.

The coordinated effort by the NIA, Enforcement Directorate (ED), and the state agencies took place all over the nation, between 1 am to 5 am in the morning last week, and more than 100 office bearers and cadre members were arrested. Soon after the arrests, the Indian citizens and political commentators are locked up in discussions and panel debates.

It's high time to understand—why PFI is a gateway to terrorism, how their vulture activism has caused damage to the Muslim society, and why every Indian citizen should appreciate the government's noncompromising action to tackle the growing menace of the Muslim Brotherhood ideology in the country.

Indeed, it's not the time to discredit the efforts and cast speculation about the crackdown by labelling it as an "election gimmick".

It's time to realise about the potential threats PFI poses to the Indian society, and also to learn the patterns of the Muslim Brotherhood ideology worldwide—the way it unleashed the catastrophe, especially in the Middle East. If PFI continues to expand, perhaps, India would witness the replication of what happened during the Arab Spring.

PFI is a gateway to terrorism

PFI is purely based on Muslim Brotherhood ideology, that started in Egypt in 1928 by Hasan Al-Banna, later Syed Qutb took the steering and it spread all across the Middle East. The ideology is based on the restoration of Caliphate by all means possible.

PFI's ideological partners are Jamat-e-Islami and Al-Ikhwanul-Muslimeen.

In fact, the banned Islamist militant outfit Students Islamic Organization of India (SIMI) was part of Jamat-e-Islami. After SIMI's ban in 2001, some of its members dispersed and formed National Development Front (NDF) in Kerala in 2006, which later merged with Karnataka Forum For Dignity (KFD), and gave birth to PFI.

In fact, the Kerala government in 2012 claimed that PFI was "nothing but a resurrection of the banned outfit SIMI in another form".

At the same time—not to miss out the fact that PFI follows Hamas methodology. Hamas which is the militant wing of the Muslim Brotherhood organisation, which was preceded by the Palestinian Muslim Brotherhood.

Arndt Emmerich—Germany's Postdoctoral Researcher at the Max Weber Institute for Sociology at the University of Heidelberg, wrote about PFI's core ideology.

He mentioned in his book, Islamic Movements in India (Chapter: 'Islamic Pragmatism and Legal Education', page-153),



"The PFI chairman advised me to study what kind of Islam has influenced our movement: Why are we not like the Tablighi Jamaat or the Salafis? We are more like Hamas, a religiously inspired community organization'.

On 20 October, 2018, Vice President Hüseyin Oru of the Turkish nonprofit organisation IHH and IHH Secretary-General Durmu? Aydn met with two important PFI leaders, EM Abdul Rahiman and Professor P Koya.

The Investigative Project on Terrorism in the Middle East Forum asserts that IHH has sent funds to Hamas' military wing, which has utilised the funds to acquire weapons and construct training centres. Whether Hamas, Hizbut-Tahrir, AI Qaeda and ISIS, all these terror outfits are the brainchildren of Muslim Brotherhood. Though they carry different names, and different working styles, their ultimate goal is the same—the Caliphate. For this reason, followers and sympathizers of these groups get absorbed into each other very easily.

The radical and violent nature of PFI remains no secret, which has ensnared numerous youngsters into the quagmire of terrorism and extremism.

During the recent raids—NIA disclosed that the PFI had created a "hit list" with prominent members of a certain group as its targets. To prevent more bloodshed in the nation, the investigating agency has presented the court with the necessary

NIA gave the statement that, "These searches were conducted at the houses and offices of the top PFI leaders and members in connection with five cases registered by the NIA following continued inputs and evidence that the PFI leaders and cadres were involved in funding of terrorism and terrorist activities, organising training camps for providing armed training and radicalising people to join banned organisations."

PFI activists joined ISIS

According to Indian Express, 40 to 50 people from the Kannur district, mostly from the Valapattanam area, have joined the Islamic State in Syria.

According to the police, they were PFI activists "militant elements" who left the organization when the Social Democratic Party of India (SDPI) was founded in 2009. These "militant elements" travelled to Syria along with their families. Some of them got killed while some of them ended up in the refugee camps.

In 2017, Kerala Police identified six PFI members from the Kannur district who joined ISIS. They were Abdul Ghayoom, Abdul Manaf, Shameer, Safwan, Suhail and his wife Rizwana.

In the same year, police registered a case after two men were arrested in Turkey who

were trying to sneak into Syria to join ISIS. They were part of the Kannur module of the Islamic State. A passing fact is—Turkey played a vital role in facilitating ISIS joinees travelling all over from Europe, India and Pakistan. As John Rossomondo talks about the process in his book Arab Spring Ruse, that Turkey's intelligence agency MIT trained and mobilised the terrorists in Syria through its southern border.

Meanwhile, PFI's India-2047 document, page-7, praises Turkey as the "flag-bearer of Islam" and that "In the last few years, PFI has developed friendly relationship with Turkey".

Sane Muslim voices against PFI

A year before the ban, Delhi-based Islamic scholar Shaykh Mohammed Rehmani of Jamia Sanabil, was asked about PFI in a public gathering in Hubli, and later in Hyderabad in May 2022, where he was invited for a counter-extremism conference held by a Muslim organisation.

At both the places—he made a clear-cut response that PFI carries the 'Khawarij' tendencies. Khawarij was the first group of terrorists who rose during the time of third caliph of Islam Uthman Al-Affan, who rebelled against the state and called for an armed struggle against the government in the name of liberty and justice. They infact assassinated the authorities of their time.

Shaykh Rehmani urged Muslims to stay away from them, and to never give them funds.

Another Islamic scholar Shaykh Abu Rizwan Mohammedi during his Friday sermon last week called PFI as the deviant organisation, and that Muslim Ulema have been warning the members of the community especially youth against it for a long time.

After the ban, Aarif Hamid from Punjab tweeted, "The ban on PFI and related organization should be permanent. They use Islam and Muslims for money and politics. Ignorant youth join them blindly without giving a read to their dangerous agenda. We thank Govt. for such a great decision. Long live India.³ Mohammed Abdul Razzag Salafi from Hyderabad tweeted, "Alhamdulillah. Finally, PFI is banned". "Ek aur bade fitne ka khatma shuru hogahya hai" -- "Game of a big trial is over". After last week's mass arrests of PFI functionaries all over the nation, Mohd Ubaidullah Shareef from Hyderabad commented "This should have happened long before. PFI may have radicalised many youngsters. Finally, a sigh of relief. Another person Mohammed Masud praised God, "Al Hamdulillah". While Nazmul Haider commented, "Good job", and Mukhtar Bin Ahamed said, "Thanks NIA". Apart from these handful of comments, a lot of Muslims expressed a sigh of relief. This shows that most of them were disgusted by the PFI's activities in the country, which were exploiting their identity.

the Congress has tended to club him with two previous defectors, Himanta Biswa Sarma and Jyotiraditya Scindia. Like them, he left the party because he felt that his personal growth prospects were better in the BJP.

I'll return to this trio later, but let me first draw attention to two women politicians whose contrasting careers are equally illustrative of the death wish that the Indian National Congress is apparently possessed with.

The first is Mahua Moitra. Raised in a middle-class, Bengali-speaking home in Assam, Moitra studied mathematics and economics at one of the best women's colleges in the United States. On graduating, she joined JP Morgan Chase, where she worked for a decade in New York and London. She could have lived on in a great Western city, rising up the corporate ladder. However, at the age of 35, she gave up a lucrative job overseas to enter public life in India by joining the Congress. Perhaps sensing that the party was going nowhere, she moved to the Trinamool Congress (TMC), where

she has since done extremely well, her rise enabled by her own intelligence, commitment, and oratory.

After joining the TMC, Moitra patiently worked her way up the political hierarchy. Rather than lobby for a Rajya Sabha seat - the preferred

pathway for well-educated professionals who join politics - she first fought, and won, an Assembly seat, before fighting, and winning, a Lok Sabha seat. In the few opportunities she got to speak in parliament, she made a considerable impression, as she did in her interviews to the press. In the recent Assembly elections in West Bengal, Moitra assiduously campaigned in many constituencies, playing her part in the TMC's resounding victory.

To know how and why the Congress finds itself in the sorry state it is, one need only contrast Mahua Moitra's political journey with that of Priyanka Gandhi's. For many years focused on her family and children, it was only in March 2019 that Priyanka formally joined the Congress, in the elevated post of General Secretary. She owed this spectacular high-level entry to her family name. As the sister of the incumbent Congress President and with both her parents having been Congress Presidents too, there was no question - the Congress being what it is of Priyanka Gandhi ever having to prove herself as an ordinary party worker before being assigned wider responsibilities. In fact, she has had no reason to prove herself after becoming General Secretary either.

In the two years Priyanka Gandhi has been in charge of Uttar Pradesh, there has been no perceptible change in the Congress's political fortunes in that state.

That fifth-generation dynasts control the Congress Party is repugnant to many people, including this now elderly historian of Indian nationalism, who has spent much of his career researching how the party of the freedom struggle nurtured the idea of an independent, democratic, and non-sectarian Republic. However, one could suppress one's distaste if these dynasts had a decent track record at winning elections, and could thus effectively thwart the ongoing dismantling of the Republic by Modi, Shah, and the Sangh Parivar. It is because they are so manifestly incompetent at retaining or regaining political power that so many people, appalled at the

destructive stranglehold that Sonia Gandhi and her children have over the country's oldest political party.

The political incompetence of Rahul and Priyanka Gandhi was reflected in the recent Assembly elections. The Congress was wiped out in West Bengal, where they forged an alliance with the Left, rather than swallow their pride and fight - as they did in Tamil Nadu - as a junior partner of a popular regional party. (Afterwards, one prominent West Bengal Congressman commented that elections are not won on Twitter.) In Assam, the Congress lost for the second successive time. The most shocking result, however, was in Kerala - where, despite Rahul Gandhi himself being an MP from the state, for the first time in half-a-century, power did not alternate between the Communists and the Congress.

The departure of Himanta Biswa Sarma and Jyotiraditya Scindia (less so Jitin Prasada) is another manifestation of the political incompetence of the Gandhi family. Denied a shot at the Chief Ministership of Assam, the am-

> bitious Sarma moved over to a party he had attacked all his life, eventually being rewarded with the post he had so desperately wanted. Denied a Rajya Sabha seat by the Congress (which went to the old family loyalist Digvijaya Singh instead), Scindia moved over to the BJP too. I hold no brief for either politician, and view with dismay their overnight conversion to Hindutva, but the fact remains that the Congress lost Assam to the BJP in good part because they could not keep Sarma, and lost MP to the BJP largely because they could not keep Scindia.

Those who wish for a change of government in 2024 must surely recognize that the Congress is at present by far the weakest link in the Opposition. narcotics has increased in quantum and size post the withdrawal of United States troops from Afghanistan in August 2021, especially in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR), a top Indian Navy official said on Tuesday. Vice Admiral Ajendra Bahadur Singh, Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Western Naval Command, said China's footprint in the maritime domain of IOR has grown manifold over the last decade, with increasing presence of its warships, research and fishing vessels apart from merchant ships. He termed the ongoing Russia-Ukraine war, which started on February 24, as a "landmark" event which has already started shaping a shift in global geo-politics and world economy.He also pointed out to the extensive fishing by large fishing trawlers belonging to extra regional countries, especially China, operating in the North Arabian Sea. Although not in India's Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ), the detrimental effect of He said narco-trafficking constitutes

fish catch merits coordinated action by all coastal nations, Vice Admiral Singh said.Narcotics trade has increased in quantum and size post the US withdrawal (from Afghanistan). Much of the narcotics are coming from Afghanistan, Pakistan and Iran, he said. The senior Navy officer was responding to a question at the 'Arabian Sea Dialogue', a seminar organised by the Observer Research Foundation here. In his address at the event, Vice Admiral Singh said the withdrawal of US forces from Afghanistan after two decades has once again created instability in the region and it would take some time for the situation to stabilize. F-16 aid to Pakistan: US responds to Indian foreign minister Jaishankar's critical remarks

(By Staff Reporter) Responding to Indian foreign minister S Jaishankar's criticism against the US providing a multimilliondollar security package to Pakistan, the Biden administration defended its decision, saying Washington doesn't view its ties with New Delhi and Islamabad "in relation to one another". "We don't view our relationship with Pakistan... our relationship with India... in relation to one another... both partners of ours with different points of emphasis...," state department spokesperson Ned Price told reporters."We look to both as partners, because we do have in many cases shared values. We do have in many cases shared interests. And the relationship we have with India stands on its own. The relationship we have with Pakistan stands on its own," he said.

Jaishankar on Sunday lashed out at US for providing a \$450 million package to Pakistan for technical and logistics services for follow-on support of F-16 fighter jet

fleets. The F-16 jets were first provided by the US to Pakistan as a reward for its assistance in the first Afghan war. The decision to provide military aid to Pakistan incensed India as the F-16 was used against Indian warplanes following the 2019 Balakot air strikes— a bombing raid conducted by Indian Air Force in Pakistan-occupied

camps. Speaking at a community event in Washington, DC, Jaishankar referred to an argument made by the US that the F-16 sustenance package is to fight terrorism. "Everybody knows where and against whom F-16 fighter jets are used. You're not fooling anybody by saying these things."

Pakistan Army helicopter crashes in Balochistan, killing all six on board

(News Agency) A helicopter carrying six tweeted the Pakistan PM. The helicopter Pakistan Army officials crashed in the country's southwestern region of Harnai, Balochistan. All six officials aboard, including two majors were killed in the accident, according to Pakistan's Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR). "All six personnel on board, including two pilots, have embraced shahadat," said ISPR, the media wing of the army. Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif took to Twitter to share his condolences and said the nation stood with the families of the bereaved. "The heart is deeply saddened by the martyrdom of six army personnel including two pilots in the accident of Pakistan Army helicopter in Harnai Balochistan. We pray to allah almighty to give the martyrs a place in Jannat al-Firdous and give patience to their families. The entire nation shares the grief of the bereaved families,"

Indian climber among 12 injured as avalanche hits Nepal's Mt. Manaslu

(News Agency) Indian climber Baljeet Kaur was among 12 climbers who were injured when an avalanche struck them at the base camp of Mt. Manaslu in Nepal on Monday, according to media reports.Out of the 12 mountaineers, three were critically injured, The Himalayan Times newspaper reported. The Department of Tourism confirmed that the avalanche hit at 11:30 am on Monday. Sources told local media that Sherpa climbers from Seven Summit Treks, Satori Adventure, Imagine Nepal Treks, Elite Expedition, and 8K Expeditions, among others, were injured.

Pemba Sherpa from 8K Expedition said Indian climber Kaur and her Sherpa guide both suffered minor injuries and were safe, the <mark>report said. The Tourism</mark> Department is yet to establish contact with the officials at the incident site, The Kathmandu Post newspaper reported, quoting the Director of the department. The avalanche struck the route just below Camp IV of Mount Manaslu when the climbers were ferrying logistics to the high camps. Rescue operations are underway and various helicopter services are conducting aerial searches.

for its political interests, top Tibetan administration Kashag has promulgated its stand on the 14th Dalai Lama. The Kashag of the Central Tibetan


Administration (CTA) declared its firm stand on prophecy and said it believes that His Holiness the Dalai Lama will live up to 113 years.

They also rejected any sort of interference from any party who doesn't believe in rebirth, stating, "Reincarnation of lama/tulku is a unique religious system of Tibetan Buddhism requiring

someone to substantially believe in past and future lives."

Kashang also reiterated Dalai Lama's personal authority in taking the complete decision about His Holiness' reincarnation according to the successive instructions of His Holiness since 1969, and the announcement on September 24, 2011. The communist party officials these days have

frequently propagated distorted narrations about Tibet's reincarnation system, especially about His Holiness the 14th Dalai China. Lama, to Tibetans in Tibet through



speeches. The CTA reported that since the Chinese government's introduction of 'Management Measures for the Reincarnation of Living Buddhas in Tibetan Buddism' in 2007, the Communist Party of China has consistently misused its authority recognising reincarnations. According to the Buddhist beliefs in the principle of reincarnation, the Dalai Lama will be able to choose any body into which he is reincarnated. It is the responsibility of High Lamas of Geluga tradition and the Tibetan government to find the next Dalai Lama.

Once identified, the successful candidate and family are taken to Lhasa (or Dharamshala) where the child studies the Buddhist scriptures to prepare for spiritual leadership.

But, according to China, there are established procedures for

Biden keeps US target for refugee admissions at 1,25,000

Despite pressure from advocates to raise the nation's cap on refugee admissions, US President Joe Biden kept refugee admissions at 125,000 for the budget year 2023

(SAI Bureau) President Joe Biden on Tuesday kept the nation's cap on refugee admissions at 125,000 for the 2023 budget year, despite pressure from advocates to raise it even higher to meet the need after falling far short of that target this year.

Refugees advocates have been pushing the Biden administration to do more to restore the U.S. Refugee Admissions Program. The more than four-decade-old program suffered deep cuts under the Trump administration, which slashed admissions to a record low of 15,000.

After taking office, Biden quadrupled the number of refugee admissions permitted for the remaining months of the 2021 budget year. He then set the target at 125,000 for the 2022 budget year, which ends Sept. 30. But so far fewer than 20,000 refugees have been admitted.That number excludes the roughly 180,000 Ukrainians and Afghans who came to the United States via a legal process called humanitarian parole that got them into the country more quickly than the traditional refugee program but only allows for stays of up to two years. 

Bangladesh at 50, Sheikh Hasina at 76: Can the Daughter of the East keep up the fight against Islamic radicals?

But, Hasina will also be remembered for her role in the restoration of democracy by bringing down a local military regime, like her father had brought the Pakistani military junta - and then in sustaining it against a persisting threat from radical Islamist forces that threaten her regime with violent street agitations, terror strikes and systematic disinformation. Not to mention about as many as 19 assassination attempts so far she has encountered, mostly orchestrated by radical elements.

Taking into account her first term into power (1996-2001), coupled with her straight third term since 2009 clearly made her the longest serving women leader across the globe, leaving behind Germany's Angela Markel.

EU Proposes New Russia Sanctions Including Oil Price Cap Over Latest 'Escalation' in Ukraine

"Last week, Russia has escalated the invasion of Ukraine to a new level," European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen said. She listed the "sham" referendums staged by Russia in the occupied regions of Ukraine, Moscow's military mobilisation and President Vladimir Putin's "threat to use nuclear weapons"."We're determined to make the Kremlin pay for this further escalation," von der Leyen said. As part of the new round of sanctions - which has to be signed off by the bloc's 27 nations — the commission is laying out a "legal basis" for a price cap on Russian oil, in line with an agreement by the G7.It will also look to ban Russian exports worth \$7 billion and tighten restrictions on goods flowing from the EU that could help Russia's war machine.

"The aim is here to deprive the Kremlin's military occupational forces, later her parents, complex of key technologies," von der Leyen said. "For example, this includes additional aviation items, or electronic components and specific chemical

substances." The proposal includes a prohibition on Europeans sitting on the board of Russian state-owned companies. EU foreign policy chief Josep Borrell said the blacklisted individuals would also include those helping Moscow to circumvent sanctions.

The bloc has already imposed seven waves of unprecedented sanctions on Moscow since it invaded its pro-Western neighbour at the end of February. The EU has already agreed a ban in May on most oil flowing from Russia to the bloc, to take full effect in December. The push for an oil price cap is aimed at limiting how much third countries, such as China and India, pay for Russian crude. To get there, it would include restrictions on European firms shipping and ensuring Russian oil cargoes heading to the rest of the globe. The Baltic states, Ireland and Poland had pushed for stronger measures to be taken in this latest round, among them restricting cooperation with Russia's commercial nuclear sector.

Garba, Dandiya, Durga Puja, Navratri: What scriptures say about their origin

Every single Indian festival has its own speciality and importance wherein it gets related to that seasonal food and behaviour

Hinduism is the only culture where women are worshipped. Every single Indian festival has its own speciality and importance wherein it gets related to that seasonal food and behaviour. Some festivals are related to harvest. So, our forefathers revolved these festivals around the above things to express our gratitude to Devtas and to express our joy. Diwali and Holi have their own hues and celebrations. Ganapati, at one time, was a regional celebration but now has become a national favorite. Although Ganesh Chaturthi is the longest celebration of 10-11 days, Navratri is outstanding among them.

As per Skanda Puran (Uttarardha 72.85-89). During the Navratri every year, pilgrimages should perform festivals towards Bhagwati by the devotees along with the members of their families, seeking blessings and favor. If anyone of evil intellect fails to perform the annual religious festival of Durga Mata, there shall be thousands of obstacles at every step for him or her.

This denotes that this festival attaches importance to gaiety and joy, with pilgrimage being an integral part of the celebration. South India has its own Golu. So this universal festival expresses its joy in various forms. Some people sing and chant devotional songs. Some observe a nine-day fast, especially the people of the north.

So also, people of the Western region celebrate this festival by playing Garba and Dandiya, particularly in Gujarat. As per Shri Kanti Patel (Renowned Gujarati Author and Critic), Poet Dayaram and Vallabh Bhatt had written Garba and Garbi in the worship of Amba, both narrating the importance of Pawagarh or Ambaji. Garba is the song sung during Ashwin Navratri praising Maa Durga. The peasants are in the end stage of the harvesting festival, so it is thanksgiving to Maa Bhagwati for taking care of her children. Some fast some feast in this festival.

Eastern India feasts and rejoices as a mark of respect to Maa Durga in the form of Durga Puja. This dance origin comes from Dwapar Yuga; as per Bhagwat Puran 10.29.1, it was during the Autumn season this dance was performed by Krishna and Gopis, Many Traditional Sages believe this dance as Atama meeting Parmatma,

and hence entire Guiarat celebrates it with great joy. Also, it is mentioned, as per Skanda Puran Uttara 72.85-89, A hint of joy and festivity during this celebration is indicated for these 9 days. As per Shiv Puran chapter 51.73 - 82, the following narrative proves how ancient this festival is. Bengal has a great significance in Durga Puja, as to the Tourism department of West Bengal 2018; as per recorded history in Bengal, the 1st Durga Puja celebration was done in the 15th Century; Dinajpur and Malda started the first Durga Puja celebration in Bengal. Many local people believe that Raja Kangshanarayan of Taherpur or Bhabananda Mazumdar of Nadiya held the Ashwin Durga Puja in Bengal in the year 1606. Even it is said that The Baroyari started Durga Puja with 12 friends of Guptipara in Hoogly, West Bengal, who started the first community puja, which was known as Baroyari Puja(Baro means 12& Yari means Friends) in 1790. This Puja entered Kolkata in 1832 by Raja Harinath of Cossimbazar, who performed the Durga Puja.

As per Shiv Puran Uma Samhita Chapter 51.73-82, It says the devotee shall observe the holy rites of Navratri in the Shukla Paksha of Ashwin and fulfill his desires. None of the Devtas, neither Brahma nor Shiva nor Karttikeya nor anyone else, can describe the importance of the rites of Navratri. By performing the Navratri rituals, King Suratha, son of Virata, regained his lost kingdom. The intelligent king of Ayodhya, Sudarshana, son of Dhruvasandhi, secured the lost kingdom. Performing this great rite and propitiating the goddess. Makes you free from worldly bondage for attaining Moksha. Shiva fulfills all the mental desires when Ashwin Navratri performs.

Navratri and Kanya Pujan as per Devi Puran. Twice a year in the season of Sharad and Vasant, in the months of Ashwin and Chaitra, Maa Bhagwati visits our home for nine days. The Navratri days are the most sacred days as even Devtas worship Durga Bhagwati on these days. Her blessings are more important since this time of the year brings diseases due to weather changes. The following Puja of Navratri is mentioned in Devi Puran. King Sudarshan, a descendant of Shri Ram, had done this Puja at Kashi to honor the Aadi Shakti who had destroyed the evil Shatrujit at Kashi, followed by King Subahu. As per Devi Bhagwat (30.18 Tritiya Khand), Shri Ram had also performed Devi Puja at Kishkindha when he went in search of Sita as instructed by Narad. As mentioned by Narad in the same chapter(21), this Yagya was performed by Brahma, Vishnu Mahesh, and other Devtas in Swarga. Worshipping the Paramba Shakti was done from the beginning. The nine-day puja should be done as per the Scrip tures. It is better to arrange the required materials a day prior to Navratri. First, select a clean spot for the creation of a Vedi or platform. Ideally, the floor should be applied with a paste of cow dung and white mud along with pillars decorated with Dhwaja (Flag) and streamers. Cover this erected Vedi with a silken cloth. Place the Devi statue in the center and a Kalash next to it. The Kalash should be filled with the sacred water of Rivers. On top of the Kalash, insert five leaves (Betel, Mango, etc.). You can also put a Navarna Yantra instead of a statue. The ideal Muhurat for this Ghat Sthapana is Nanda Tithi in Hasta Nakshatra. Make the offerings of Chandan, Agar, Camphor, Flowers

of Mandaar, Champa, and Bilwa leaves along with Dhoop and Deep; for Havan, prepare a triangular Kund with a separate Vedi or Platform. Thrice a day puja is ideal. The Yajman has to sleep on the floor all nine days. If you cannot fast all nine days, the last three days of Saptami, Ashtami, and Navmi also give you the desired results. Remember all the Devtas, too, who are busy worshipping the Aadi Shakti.

Kumari Pujan: Actually, you have to start Kumari Puja by worshipping one Kumari on the first day, two on the second, and likewise go on increasing the numbers per day. So, on the last day, you worship nine Kumarikas. The offering should be of food, clothing, and Jewellery. If you are unable to do Kumari Puja each day, then you can perform this on Ashtami since Bhadrakali had appeared on that day to destroy the Havan Kund of Daksha. Give the things as per your ability. The minimum age for a Kumari should be two years of age and above, and the maximum age should not exceed ten years. Following is the table indicating the name and age of Kumarika.

Giant telescopes that focus their lenses at the unending cosmos from the surface of Earth have to be constructed at carefully selected sites. Work of the telescope must not get hindered due to ordinary weather phenomemon like fog, clouds rains etc. Hence, such giant telescopes are installed in remote places, high on mountains or in deserts and so on.

But now even such care taken while choosing the site for the telescopes may not be adequate to ensure that work is not hampered. A study says that climate change may create problems for scientists using these telescopes. The study was carried out by researchers in University of Bern and the National Centre of Competence in Research (NCCR).

"Even though telescopes usually have a lifetime of several decades, site selection processes only consider the atmospheric conditions over a short timeframe. Usually over the past five years - too short to capture long-term trends, let alone future changes caused by global warming," explained study lead author Caroline Haslebacher. She has been quoted by Earth.com"Nowadays, astronomical observatories are designed to work under the current site conditions and only have a few possibilities for adaptation. Potential consequences of the climatic conditions for telescopes therefore include a higher risk of condensation due to an increased dew point or malfunctioning cooling systems, which can lead to more air turbulence in the telescope dome," she added.

"This is the first time that such a study has been possible. Thanks to the higher resolution of the global climate models developed through the Horizon 2020 PRIMAVERA project, we were able to examine the conditions at various locations of the globe with great fidelity - something that we were unable to do with conventional models. These models are valuable tools for the work we do at the Wyss Academy," said study co-author Marie-Estelle Demory.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is to inaugurate the Mahakaleshwar Corridor, constructed in Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain at a cost of Rs 350 crore, on October 11.

Here is a look at the project and what it entails.

What is the Mahakal corridor?

Mahakal Maharaj Mandir Parisar Vistar Yojna is a plan for the expansion, beautification, and decongestion of the Mahakaleshwar temple and its adjoining area in Ujjain district.

Under the plan, the Mahakaleshwar temple premises of around 2.82 hectares is being increased to 47 hectares, which will be developed in two phases by the Ujjain district administration. This will include the 17 hectares of Rudrasagar lake. The project is expected to increase annual footfall in the city from the current 1.50 crore to nearly three crore.

First phases of the Mandir Parisar Vistar Yoina

One of the aspects of the Vistar Yojna's first phase is a visitor plaza with two entrances or Dwaars — the Nandi Dwaar and the Pinaki Dwaar. The visitor plaza can hold up to 20,000 pilgrims at a time. A circulation plan to reduce congestion has also been developed, keeping in mind the entry of visitors into the city and their movement up to the temple.

Decentralised parking has been provided at various entry points and vehicular movement into the expanded temple area has been restricted. Facilities like ticketing kiosks have been provided at the entry plaza.

A 900-metre pedestrian corridor has been constructed, connecting the plaza to the Mahakal temple, dotted with 108 murals and 93 statues depicting stories related to Lord Shiva, such as Shiv Vivah, Tripurasur Vadh, Shiv Puran, and Shiv Tandav Swaroop. There are also 128 convenience points, eateries and shopping joints, florists, handicraft stores, etc. along this pedestrian corridor.

The first phase is complete and will be inaugurated by PM Modi on October 11. In a cabinet meeting held on Tuesday in Ujjain, the Mahakal corridor was renamed as Mahakal Lok.

What is the second phase of the plan?

The second phase, pegged at Rs 310.22 crore, includes expansion of the eastern and northern fronts of the temple. It also includes development of various areas of Ujjain city, such as Maharajwada, Mahal Gate, Hari Phatak Bridge, Ramghat façade, and Begam Bagh Road.

Buildings in Maharajwada will be redeveloped and connected to the Mahakal temple campus, while a heritage dharamshala and Kumbh museum will be built.

The second phase is being developed with funding from Agence Francaise de Development (AFD) under the City Investments to Innovate Integrate and Sustainable (CITIIS) programme.

The work to rehabilitate affected people is on. When was the project conceptualised?

The Mahakal redevelopment project has become the most recent bone of contention between the ruling BJP and the Opposition Congress. At the special cabinet held in Ujjain on September 27, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan credited his government for conceptualising the project in 2017 at a cost of Rs 95 crore. He accused the Congress government, which came to power in 2018, of putting the project in cold storage.

Meanwhile, countering Chouhan's claim, state Congress president Kamal Nath said it was in August 2019 that his government drew the sketch of the Mahakal Temple and allocated Rs 300 crore for it. A three-member ministerial committee was appointed to finalise and execute the plan in a time-bound manner, he claimed.

The increase is based on the recommendations of the 7th pay commission. The latest hike will amount to a dearness allowance of 38 per cent for the central government employees. The last increase in dearness allowance was announced in March, with effect from January 1, 2022. The DA increase in March was 3 per cent over the previous rate of 31 per cent. Dearness Allowance is provided by the central government for its employees to adjust to the inflation-like situation. Pensioners also get dearness relief same as the amount received by the employees of the central government.

Looking to Rent a Bank Locker? Here's Everything you Should Know to Protect Your Assets

(News Agency) People often use safe lockers in banks to store valuables such as jewellery and property papers. In 2021, Reserve Bank of India changed the rules related to bank lockers which are effective since January 2022. The primary objective of these bank locker rules was to protect expensive assets from theft and burglaries. With

trembling economic inequality, jewelry and cash thefts are still prevalent in many parts of India

Fraud Prevention Rules Introduced Every time you will access the locker, you will be alerted through e-mail and SMS through the bank. The objective of the rule is to prevent fraud.

Also, the bank has the right to rent a locker for a maximum period of three years. For instance, if the locker rent is Rs 2000, the bank should not charge you more than Rs 6000, excluding other maintenance charges. RBI has made it mandatory to monitor the people coming and going into the locker room through CCTV cameras. Moreover, the data of CCTV footage will have to be stored for six months. In case of a security lapse or theft, the police will be able to investigate through the CCTV footage.

Compensation In Case Of Theft Earlier, banks were not responsible for the loss of items in your



locker. You could not claim financial damages from them. There are instances of thefts at banks where lockers were broken into. However, the locker owners were not compensated for those losses. Now, according to the RBI, the person will be entitled to compensation if any valuable item gets stolen from a customer's bank locker.

Banks will have to pay up to 100 times the annual locker rent to the customer as compensation Banks are responsible for ensuring the security and safety of the premises where the safe deposits are housed. Banks must also ensure that incidents of theft, burglary, fire,

robbery or dacoity do not occur due to lapses on their part.

Transparency Lack of transparency had always been a concern in the public sector departments. Until today, banks used to sideline the theft incidents and ignore them completely by saying that they were not responsible for it. RBI stated that in its order banks will have to show a list of empty lockers and the waiting list number of the locker.

Rent Customers, who want to get a locker in a bank, will have to pay a term deposit which will be equivalent to locker rent for three years. Banks can't charge the rent for more than three years in advance.

(News Agency) As the tropical storm lan strengthens into a hurricane, Nasa is monitoring the weather conditions at Cape Canaveral as it plans to remove the Space Launch System (SLS) with the Orion spacecraft from the launchpad. The Artemis-1 mission has been on pad for over a month with two failed attempts to launch to the Moon. Nasa decided to step down from a third launch attemt scheduled on Tuesday as the storm barreled towards the launch site. The American space agency said that it is making incremental decisions that prioritise the people and hardware and its process is in accordance with established policies for tropical storms and hurricanes.

"The latest information provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the U.S. Space Force, and the National Hurricane Center indicates a slower moving and potentially more westerly track of the storm than yesterday's predictions showed, providing more time for the agency's decision-making process," Nasa said in a blog update. A meeting is set

to be held later today to evaluate whether to roll back or remain at the launch pad to preserve an opportunity for a launch attempt on October 2. "The exact time of a potential rollback will depend on future weather predictions throughout the day and could occur Monday or very early Tuesday morning," the agency added.A decision to forego the September 27 launch opportunity was taken on Saturday as the storm intensified. Artemis-1 teams decided to stand down on preparing for the Tuesday launch date to allow them to configure systems for rolling back the Space Launch System rocket and Orion spacecraft to the Vehicle Assembly Building. 


